- About 50 homes in Edulabad village received free hand sanitizers, masks, and gloves.
  A survey was conducted and people were encouraged to get the two doses of vaccines if they had not already done so.
- The institute has taken steps to raise public awareness about social and health issues such as the dowry system, environmental protection, consumer protection awareness, anti-corruption, HIV/AIDS, tobacco control, and cleanliness, among others.
