## Anti-ragging Committee

Megha Institute of Engineering and Technology for Women's maintains a healthy and congenial academicenvironment for the students. The institution offers protection to the new entrants from the menace of

ragging. Ragging is defined as: Any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or indiscipline activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or any other student or asking the student to do any act or perform something which such student will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so asto adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or any other student. Ragging in the college is absolutely banned and, hence, any student found indulging in an act of ragging shall meet strict disciplinary action, which may include immediate rustication from the college apart from criminal consequences.

In this regard our Institute has constituted an Anti-Ragging Cell. The cell is headed by Head of the institution, along with several other committee members comprising of senior faculties. Anti-Ragging members and Anti Ragging Bus Incharges have been deputed from all departments to monitor students discipline both inside the campus and on board.
