#### REPORT

## Report Summary:

From the 10th through 12th of August 2017, Megha Institute of Engineering and Technology for Women hosted its annual celebration on the grounds of the large institution in Edulabad, Ghatkesar. Over a three-day festival, faculty and students from all college departments were invited to mingle, learn, enjoy, and celebrate their successes. Each club/discipline sponsored its own events and competitions. The Computer Science and Engineering department's coding club organised this year's event, named FUZZ EXCEPTION.

Over the first two days of the event, the Club was involved in technical operations. On the first day, Thursday 10th August 2017, a quick-fire verbal quiz with questions based on common technical grounds and coding languages was held under the label TECHNICAL QUIZ. During this phase, 92 people from various departments participated.

On the second day, August 11, 2017, the event transitioned to a new platform for generating a code based on the assigned issue,

nicknamed CODING COMPETITION. Students were allowed 2 1/2 hours to write code in their preferred programming language to tackle the stated challenge. There were 69 students present to compete in finding the strongest overall code.

The two-day event drew 142 people in total, with 19 pupils taking part in both the quiz and the coding sessions.
