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Summary of the Report:

The annual fest of the Megha Institute of Engineering and Technology for Women took place on the 8th and 9th of November 2018 on the huge college campus in Edulabad, Ghatkesar. Over a three-day festival, faculty and students from all college departments were encouraged to meet, learn, enjoy, and commemorate their achievements. Each club/discipline sponsored its own activities and competitions. This year's codeathon was organised by the Computer Science and Engineering department's coding club.

In those first two days of the event, the Club partook in technical activities. On day one, Thursday 8th November 2018, a quick-fire verbal quiz termed TECHNICAL QUIZ was conducted with questions based on common technical grounds and computer languages. During this phase, the total respondents from all departments were 49.

The event transitioned to a digital medium titled CODING COMPETITION on the second day, November 9th, 2018, where

participants must build a code based on the specified subject. Students had 2 1/2 hours to create code in their selected programming language to solve the given task. A total of 57 students competed to find the strongest feasible code.
