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Report Summary:

The annual fest of Megha Institute of Engineering and Technology for Women was held between the 22nd and 24th of August 2019 on the large college grounds in Edulabad, Ghatkesar. Over a three-day festival, students and faculty from all collegiate departments were welcomed to attend, explore, enjoy, and celebrate their success. Each club/discipline initiated its own activities and contests. This year's event, RUNTIME TERROR, was hosted by the Computer Science and Engineering department's coding club.

The Club participated in technical events in the first two days of the festival. On the day one, Thursday, August 22, 2019, a TECHNICAL QUIZ comprising questions based on the common technical grounds was held. The total participants from across all departments was 63 during this phase.

On the second day, August 23, 2019, the event transitioned to a digital platform for generating a code based on the specified theme, branded as CODING COMPETITION. Participants were instructed to write code in 2 1/2 hours using their preferred programming language to

tackle the stated challenge. There had been 56 students present to compete in finding the finest possible code.

Rathod Latha coordinated with the sponsors and organisers to make the entire two-day event pleasant, joyful, and peaceful. The two-day event drew 104 people in all, with 15 pupils taking part in both the quiz and the coding sessions. The winners of both categories were announced on the last day of the festival's technical phase; the Honourable Chief Guest Dr.M.Venu Gopal Garu on the second day, August 23rd. E Madhumitha gave a vote of thanks to all of the primary members of the crew, supervisors, coordinators, pupils, lecturers, management staff, guests, and, most especially, participants who helped make the festival a huge success.
