### REPORT

### Report Summary:

The annual festival of Megha Institute of Engineering and Technology for Women was hosted on the massive college campus at Edulabad, Ghatkesar, between the 28th and 30th of April 2022. Faculty and students from all college departments were encouraged to participate, learn, enjoy, and celebrate their progress over a three-day festival in which each club/discipline sponsored its own events and competitions. RENDEVOUZ was the name of the event this year, which was organised by the Computer Science and Engineering department's coding club.

Throughout the first two days of the festival, the Club took part in technical activities. On the first day, Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2022, a quick-fire verbal quiz called TECHNICAL QUIZ was held with questions based on common technical grounds and coding languages. During this section, the total number of participants from all departments came to 73.

On the second day, i.e.29<sup>th</sup> April 2022 the event moved onto a digital platform for creating a code based on the topic given, named as CODING COMPETITION. Students were given 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> hours to create a code to solve the given problem in their desired programming language. 46 students turned up to compete against each other in finding the best possible code.

The total participants for the two-day event were 102, with 17 students participating in both the quiz and the coding sessions.
