REPORT

Report Summary:

The annual fest of Megha Institute of Engineering and Technology for Women was held between 7th and 9th of July 2016on the vast college campus atEdulabad, Ghatkesar. During this time all the faculty and students from all our departments were encouraged to collaborate, learn, enjoy and celebrate the success witha 3-day-long festival where all the clubs/disciplines organised their own events and competitions. This year, the presentation club from the department of Computer Science and Engineering organised the event under the name, TALKING TITANS.

The Club took part during the first two days of the fest, during which the technical events were held. On the first day of the event, i.e. Thursday 7th July 2016, a non-digital presentation competition, namely Poster Presentation competition, where the students made arts and pictographs on charts showcasing their ideas about a topic of their choice. The participants on the first day were86 from across all departments belonging to all years.

On the second day, i.e. 8th July 2016, the event moved onto a digital platform for presentation, named as PPT Presentation competition. Here students made digital presentations of the topic of one's choice using software such as Microsoft PowerPoint to showcase their views. The number of people willing to participate on this day increased by 17 compared to the first day, meaning 103 people participated in this event.

The entire two days' event was hosted by Ms. Rubeena Sultana, who coordinated with the club mentors to have a knowledgeable, successful and harmonious event. The total number of participants across the 2days' event added upto a grand total of 142, of which 47 students took part in both the digital and non-digital segments of the event.
