REPORT

Report Summary:

Megha Institute of Engineering and Technology for Women's Annual Fest was conducted from August 22nd to 24th, 2019 in the large college campus in Edulabad, Ghatkesar. During this time, all departmental professors and students are welcome to engage, learn, enjoy, and celebrate accomplishment in a three-day festival where all clubs organise their own activities and competitions. This year's event organized by the Presentation Club from the Department of Computer Science and Engineering under the banner of TALK IT OUT.

During the first two days of the event, the Club engaged in technical competitions. On the first day of the event, Thursday, August 22, 2019, a analogue presentation competition, namely a poster presentation competition, was held in which students made artworks and illustrations on charts displaying their views regarding a topic of their choice. On this day, 28 students from various departments and years took part.
